

New Life

The Easter mystery of Christ death and resurrection lies at the heart of the Church's liturgical life. Today we celebrate the Resurrection of Christ, his return to life after his crucifixion. In Gospel stories we see Mary Magdalene and the disciples caught up in their sense of grief and failure. They wanted a political Messiah who will drive out all their enemies and restore their kingdom to its greatness. After Jesus" resurrection, the disciples let go of their expectations, they accepted the reality of not trying to do their will but God's will.

In everybody there is a desire to change. There is a desire to set aside the less perfect for the more perfect; to rise after a fall; to better one's financial situation; to improve one's health; to overcome one's faults. We often try to hide our faults and mistakes from sight. Wisdom is not in denial but in acceptance. Change does not come by hiding or denying a problem, rather, it comes through an acceptance of honest self acknowledging. Painful feeling happens as the result, but we have to accept it and work through it, then we will live joyfully and meaningfully. In the Passion of Christ we see Jesus face the horrible suffering and death freely and willingly. "Father! Everything is possible for you. Take this cup away from me. But let it be as you, not I, would have it." In accepting the will of his Heavenly Father. Jesus was able to eventually transcend the limits of his humanity and rise from the death.

Easter is about new life that is about acknowledging the reality of the ordinary patterns of our lives, with the hope and joy of resurrection. Let us pray that we will be able to live our life with an open heart and mind to the will of God so that we can recognise the wonder and beauty in us and in others.

Catechism of the Catholic Church

641 Mary Magdalene and the holy women who came to finish anointing the body of Jesus, which had been buried in haste because the Sabbath began on the evening of Good Friday, were the first to encounter the Risen One. Thus the women were the first messengers of Christ's resurrection for the apostles themselves. They were the next to whom Jesus appears: first Peter, then the twelve. Peter had been called to strengthen the faith of his brothers, and so sees the Risen One before them; it is on the basis of his testimony that the community exclaims:" The Lord has risen indeed, and has appeared to Simon!
