

Easter-A time to recognise

A man goes to the doctor, "Doc", he says pointing to different parts of his body. "When I touch my arm it hurts. When I touch my neck it hurts. When I touch my stomach it hurts. Every part of my body I touch, it hurts. Is there something wrong with me?" "No" the doctor replied after thoroughly checking his patient, "There is nothing wrong with you, but you have got a broken finger."

Every part of the body makes up the whole body. Today's Gospel - The Good Shepherd Sunday reminds us that Jesus considers each one of us as his own. His love and concern for us is always personal. "He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out." He knows all of us by name. There must be a true mutuality between shepherds and sheep. Good Shepherds know their own, and their own know them. Between them is mutual trust, mutual openness, mutual care and mutual love. Jesus calls himself the Good Shepherd to show the great intimacy that must exist between leaders and those entrusted to them. Without such intimacy, leadership easily becomes oppressive.

The Gospel invites us to be leaders - shepherds in various roles. Such as parents, teachers, older siblings, pastors, directors etc. Whatever our position in life may be, we are called to be compassionate leaders to those who are under our care. May we continue building up better relationships and better understanding and better functioning families and community.

Let us pray for the grace to realise that Jesus guides and inspires us always. May we who are shepherds in our own right, truly have the heart, the love and the concern of Jesus- the Good Shepherd.
