Live our faith

A young guy walked into a liquor store with a shotgun and demanded all the cash from the cash drawer. After the cashier put the cash in a bag, the robber saw a bottle of scotch that he wanted behind the counter on the shelf. He told the cashier to put it the bag as well, but he refused and said, "Because I don't believe you are over 18." The robber said he was, but the cashier still refused to give it to him because he did not believe him. At this point the robber took out his driver licence from his wallet and gave it to the cashier. The cashier looked it over, and agreed that the man was in fact over 18 so he put the bottle of scotch in the robber's bag. The robber then ran from the store with his loot. The cashier promptly called the police and he gave them the name and address of the robber that he got off his driver licence. The police arrested the robber two hours later at his home drunk. He had to give back what he took except the bottle of scotch which he had already consumed.

"Give to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God." Jesus' answer to the Pharisees who wanted to trick him by asking: "Is it lawful to pay the census tax to Caesar or not?" If he said that taxes shouldn't be paid to Caesar, then he will be denounced by the Romans. But if he said that the taxes should be paid, then he would be denounced by the strict Jews. Jesus' words encouraged us to live our convictions. We stand up for our faith and our way of life even when this puts us in opposition to the material world. We should not be concerned if we are the only ones who make time to worship and praising God and make time for family prayers since these are important to our faith and our relationship with God and others. By showing the coin with Caesar's image on it, Jesus reminds us that we ourselves have God's image impressed on us, and we must return to God what belongs to God, that is our entire being.

Let us pray that we will have the courage to live our faith in every sphere of life, in business, in our civic duty and in our personal lives so that God always is the centre of our life .

Catechism of the Catholic Church

2242 The citizen is obliged in conscience not to follow the directives of civil authorities when they are contrary to the demands of the moral order, to the fundamental rights of persons or the teachings of the gospel. Refusing obedience to civil authorities, when their demands are contrary to those of an upright conscience, finds its justification in the distinction between serving God and serving the political community. 'Render therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesar's and to God the things that are God's.' We must obey God rather than men.
